This Collections Guide summarises the main clinical records of local hospitals and sanatoria relevant to family history research. It also includes administrative records produced by hospital boards and committees, and details of medical and nursing associations. It does not list Medical Officer of Health reports unless other items of interest, such as birth registers, are included in the collection.

What types of health records survive?

The various changes in structure of the National Health Service resulted in many pre-1948 hospital records being lost or destroyed. The type of hospital also determines what types of records are more likely to survive. For example, Voluntary Hospital records are generally concerned with fund-raising and investments, whereas Poor Law Infirmaries usually kept registers of admission and removals. The fullest material is usually from mental health institutions.

The Archive Service does not hold individual patients' primary care records (General Practitioners' (GPs) records on their patients). To access your own primary care records, you should contact either your GP or the local health authority on whose medical list your most recent GP was included.

Where can I find hospital records?

West Yorkshire Archive Service holds archive records for a number of hospitals in West Yorkshire. The majority of these are held at our Wakefield office. More recent records may still be kept with the hospital if it is still in operation.

Some recent records containing information of a sensitive, personal nature are subject to legal restrictions on access. Please ask a member of staff for more details. For further information on Access to Mental Health Records see User Guide 6.

Before the National Health Service (NHS) was established in 1948, there were three main categories of hospitals. These were:

Voluntary Hospitals

Initially these hospitals were set up with the support of voluntary subscriptions, and doctors were supposed to provide a free service. By the end of the 19th century charges were introduced based on what the patient could afford to pay. There was a lot of pressure on these hospitals to be successful and so they often refused to admit chronically ill patients, children or pregnant women.

Cottage Hospitals

Cottage hospitals were also voluntary and usually refused to admit chronically ill patients. They tended to specialise [eyes, ears, chests etc] and were set up by ambitious young doctors if enough subscribers were found. They were popular as they enabled patients to stay locally for their treatment rather than being sent away to the county hospitals. They also helped local doctors and surgeons gain valuable experience and practice.

Workhouse Infirmaries

Established by the Poor Law Amendment Act of 1834, most in West Yorkshire were built in the 1850s and 1860s. Originally they were not set up as hospitals, but provided some treatment for the poor and accommodation for lunatics. Initially workhouses had no nurses to assist the medical officers, and both sick and healthy inmates were kept on the same wards. In the late 19th century the Local Government Board decided workhouses should have separate infirmaries. Workhouse patients had few rights, as they became a pauper when they entered the workhouse. Many records for workhouses have been lost since the new hospitals which developed from them wished to forget the grim workhouse image.

Other Types of Hospital:

General Charitable Hospitals

Early hospitals were charities, often linked with religious bodies. In this region they were usually founded by a bequest in a benefactor's will, leaving money or land which produced an income for the hospital's upkeep. Trustees would run the charity under the terms of a trust deed and usually added to its income by public subscriptions. The motives behind charitable hospitals were a mixture of philanthropy and self-interest. From 1853 the Charity Commission oversaw and regulated charities, and many reformed themselves with new trust deeds.

Asylums

Attitudes to insanity improved in the late 18th century. In 1808 the *County Asylums Act* allowed county justices to spend money on mental hospitals. Ten years later 'The West Riding Pauper Lunatic Asylum' (later known as Stanley Royd Hospital) opened in Wakefield. Other county asylums opened in Menston (1888) and Storthes Hall, Kirkburton (1904)

In 1889 the West Riding County Council took over most administrative work from the Quarter Sessions, and its West Riding Asylums Committee ran all the county asylums. In 1890 the *Lunacy Act* laid down detailed procedures for the reception and treatment of patients. In 1912 the West Riding County Council joined with the boroughs to set up the West Riding Asylums Board, established under the *West Riding Asylums Act* of 1912. In 1923 the name of this board was changed to the West Riding of Yorkshire Mental Hospitals Board (see WRC/40 held at Wakefield archives for minutes of this board). Under the *National Health Service Act* of 1946 this board ceased to exist when the hospitals administered by the board were transferred to the Regional Hospital Board of the National Health Service.

There were also private asylums in the 19th century, supervised by the Quarter Sessions, and some records of these are to be found in the Quarter Sessions records.

Workhouses were also used to house mental health patients, especially after 1890.

Dispensaries

Most began in the late 18th century and early 19th century as charitable providers of basic out-patient services. Some included a few beds for in-patients and then developed into full hospitals (for example Wakefield's Clayton Hospital). Most charitable hospitals included dispensaries.

Fever Hospitals

Financed by public subscription, these were a response to the epidemics produced by insanitary urban conditions in the first half of the 19th century.

Joint Isolation Hospitals

These hospitals resulted from the *Isolation Hospitals Act* of 1893. Neighbouring local authorities formed a joint committee authorised by an order of the County Council, mainly for the treatment of smallpox.

Mental Health Hospitals

These hospitals were founded under the 1913 *Mental Deficiency Act*, which marked some progress in diagnosing and treating mental illness. They were later called mental health hospitals (for example Fieldhead Hospital, Wakefield).

Tuberculosis (TB) Sanatoria

Tuberculosis was a major killer. It became a notifiable disease in the West Riding in 1912, when diagnosis and treatment were helped by the provisions of Lloyd George's *National Insurance Act* of 1911. The county was divided into ten TB districts, each with a dispensary and branch dispensaries. The scheme was run by the West Riding County Council's Public Health and Housing Committee (records are held at our Wakefield office, collection reference WRD6), through the County Medical Officer (records are held at our Wakefield office, collection reference WRD7). In 1948 the dispensaries were taken over by the National Health Service, which later renamed them chest clinics (for example the Pontefract Dispensary from 1913).

Maternity Hospitals

Some developed from 'Babies' Welcomes' run by local authorities (for example, Manygates Hospital, Wakefield) and some from District Nursing Associations financed by local subscriptions (for example, South Elmsall). Most began after World War One, and they handled only a minority of births until after World War Two.

Geriatric Hospitals

Later called 'Long stay' hospitals, few were purpose-built, most were ex-workhouses or superseded isolation hospitals (for example Wakefield's County Hospital for Old People was the former workhouse).

Emergency Medical Centres

A product of World War Two, some of these centres developed into permanent general hospitals (for example, Pinderfields, Wakefield) and some were a temporary re-allocation of parts of existing hospitals (for example, Westfield Mental Health Hospital, Bradford).

Useful Dates

- 1929 *Local Government Act* abolishes Poor Law Boards of Guardians and transfers management of workhouse hospitals to local Public Assistance Committees.
- 1948 The National Health Service was established and regional authorities were set up following the Beveridge Report of 1943.
- The NHS was divided into three parts:
- Hospital services
 - Family doctors, dentists, opticians and pharmacists who remained self-employed under a contract for services from an Executive Council
 - Local authority health services, community nursing, midwifery, health visiting, maternal and infant welfare clinics, immunisation and the control of infectious diseases
- England and Wales were divided into fourteen Regional Hospital Boards, plus Teaching Hospitals which were directly responsible to the Minister of Health. Each Regional Hospital Board controlled a number of Hospital Management Committees, which in turn were responsible for a number of hospitals in their area.
- 1958 NHS records become public records under the *Public Records Act*
- 1974 A new three-tier system of Regional, Area and District Authorities was established
- 1982 NHS restructuring was implemented to simplify the organisation. There were:
- Fourteen Regional Health Authorities
 - One hundred and ninety-two District Health Authorities
 - Seven Special Health Authorities
 - Ninety Family Practitioner Committees
- 1990 *NHS and Community Care Act* paved the way for NHS Hospital Trusts
- 2002 West Yorkshire Strategic Health Authority established covering all five West Yorkshire metropolitan districts.
