

Dear Brother,

Lisbon 24 June 1760

It is now upwards of two years and a half since I had the pleasure of hearing from you, your last bearing date of the 1st Oct 1757, & not withstanding the promise you therein made, of answering my letter on receival, as yet have not received a line from you. I wrote to my father sometime ago & mentioned to him the great desire I had that in your return home from the Suisse, you should take this place in your way, to which he answered me, that he wished he could either get you to England, or here, but that you did not choose to leave the place where you are.
